Cosmology

Mondays 11 October – 29 November 9.00am -10.30am **\$270**

Gazing at the stars we can experience the majestic love between the spiritual world & the earth that is woven into all of creation. In this course we will learn to understand the language of the stars & discover what star wisdom has to reveal to us about ourselves and our deeper star nature. We will look at both western & indigenous readings of the stars & listen to the lively conversation between astrology and astronomy. In the course we will learn to orient ourselves according to the tropical and sidereal zodiacs, phases of the moon, eclipses and the many dances of the planets. Finding correspondences between the twelvefold archetype of the zodiac and the seven fold archetype of the planets & both natural and soul phenomena will engage our creative perceptive capacities. Gazing at the stars & constructing a planet clock will engage our will.

Male and Female Spirituality

This module will assist students to develop awareness of female and male polarities and spirituality in one's personal life and through historical evolution, with reflection on the direction this is taking in contemporary society. It also seeks to enhance observation skills through Anthroposophical investigation methods by surveying and analysing our complex interpersonal relationships with reference to feminine and masculine characteristics.

Destiny

In this course we will explore the concepts and meanings of the human destiny, human karma and develop an approach to understand reincarnation from the perspective of Anthroposophy. There will be views cast into the world around us and into the lives of great people of the past, but foremost we will endeavour to cast light unto our own path of destiny and begin to grasp with questions such as who am? what is the meaning of my life? What is my relationship with others around me? Where am I going?

Feltmaking

Feltmaking is a creative process which works with the elements and strengthens the will. This course is an introduction to the ancient craft of wet felting, as well as the recent innovation of needle felting. We will paint and sculpt with wool fibre, exploring its healing and versatile qualities by creating a vessel, a "wool painting", felted balls, a pencil case, an animal, felted fruit and more. The course fee includes all materials.

Puppetry
